

TIMELINE FOR PURSUING MASTER'S DEGREE IN THE UNITED KINGDOM FOR ACADEMIC YEAR SEPT 2020



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End of Dec 2019

Prepare English skills

What to prepare: Listening, Reading, Writing, Speaking skills

Who to ask: Professional Tutor, Online exercise, etc.

End of Sept 2019

Choose the best school in some good reputation universities

Find out what are their requirements for master degree. Do they need additional test at the end of the admission process?

What to prepare: Check out some references, such as:

Who to ask: People who have finished their study, colleagues, boss, etc.

End of Oct 2019

Look at to their modules, research fields, lecturers and facilities, and the location

What to prepare:

University's website and make a study plan (about what major, course, and research would be taken).

Who to ask: Professors, Course Leader, Admission officer. (ask them by email)

End of Dec 2019

Preparing the motivation letter or personal statement and recommendation letter for university admission

What to prepare: - A good and comprehensive motivation letter or personal statement.
- A well-written recommendation letter from 2 or 3 referees (depend on the university)
*some high reputable universities like Oxford/Cambridge close their admission process at this time. So, look at to their deadline **very carefully**.

Who to ask: English tutor or people who have finished their study successfully.

End of Jan/Feb 2019

Apply to the selected university by online

What to prepare: During Jan to Feb you can prepare your documents, such as: passport, certificate, transcript, birth certificate, IELTS preparation.

Who to ask: All documents have to be well prepared in JPEG and PDF version.

August 2019- March 2020

Apply for scholarship

What to prepare: Hope during this month you will get the Letter of Acceptance (LoA) straightway from the university you applied for so it will be easier to get funding.

Who to ask: LPDP, Chevening, Universities Scholarship, Jardine, other funding institution, etc.
